Re: Standardization of Critical Value for Total and Neonatal Bilirubin

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Key Messages:

 Effective December 10, 2013, the laboratory will begin to standardize the Critical Value for bilirubin. All Zones will be completed by the end of February 2014. The table below indicates the standardized Critical Value.

		Critical Values		
Analyte	Age/Other	Less than	Greater than	Units
Bilirubin (Total and Neonatal)	< 30 days		> 300	μmol/L

Why this is important:

• The standardization of the Critical Value will provide consistency as to the level at which physicians are notified of a Critical Result.

Action required:

• The Laboratory will notify physicians when a Bilirubin result is greater than 300 µmol/L.
