Re: Changes to Reporting of Serum HCG (HCGSER)

PLEASE POST OR DISTRIBUTE AS WIDELY AS APPROPRIATE

Key Messages:

- Chinook Regional Hospital Laboratory (Lethbridge) currently reports Serum HCG results as <1 IU/L and numeric values thereafter, with a reference range of 6 IU/L.
- Effective December 3, 2015, the reporting format will change:
 - Serum HCG results less than 5 IU/L will be reported as <5 IU/L
 - Reference Range for Males/Females will be <5 IU/L
 - Result comment will auto-attach: Method Used: Siemens Vista - 4th WHO International Standard (75/589)

WARNING: Different methods give potentially significantly different numerical values. Do not compare results from method to method. Testing by the same method is required for serial monitoring.

Graphical displays (Netcare, POS) of serial data may be misleading if results are from different methods.

Why this is important:

• Provincial standardization of reporting practices across all Vista analyzers.

Action Required:

• The Meditech Lab Information System has been updated to reflect these changes.
