Re: Change to negative Blood Culture reporting times

PLEASE POST OR DISTRIBUTE AS WIDELY AS APPROPRIATE

Key Message:

- Negative blood cultures will now have a preliminary report issued after 48 hours, and a final report after 5 days of incubation. Preliminary reports will no longer be issued at 18 - 24 hours.
- Positive blood cultures will continue to be processed and reported within 1 hour of positivity.

Why This Is Important:

 In preparation for alignment with Connect Care, a change to reporting time of negative blood cultures is required.
