Re: Changes in troponin method

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## **Key Message:**

- Effective **September 16, 2020**, the primary troponin method will be changing at the following sites:
  - o Centennial Centre for Mental Health and Brain Injury in Ponoka
  - Castor
  - o Consort
  - Coronation
  - o Sylvan Lake
- The troponin reference range will change from ≤0.02 ug/L to ≤0.1 ug/L
- Due to the difference in methods, results obtained prior to September 16<sup>th</sup> at the above-mentioned locations should **NOT** be compared to those obtained on September 16<sup>th</sup> and thereafter

# Why this is Important:

- The change in troponin method is due to difficulties in ensuring adequate supplies of current troponin method reagents from the manufacturer
- Both old and new troponin methods have comparable sensitivity and do <u>NOT represent high-sensitive troponin testing</u>
