Re:	Changes to Lower Reportable Limit and Critical Value for Salicylate

PLEASE POST OR DISTRIBUTE AS WIDELY AS APPROPRIATE

Key Message:

- Effective **October 21, 2020**, the following changes will be introduced to salicylate reporting:
 - The lower reportable limit for salicylate will be changed to <0.30 mmol/L from <0.12 mmol/L.There will be no reference range or therapeutic range information provided.
 - The critical value for salicylate will be changed to <u>>2.20 mmol/L</u> from >3.62 mmol/L.
 Salicylate concentrations of 2.20 mmol/L and lower will <u>not</u> be flagged in Netcare and Physician Office Systems (POS).

Why this is Important:

• To standardize laboratory nomenclature, reporting and processes within APL South Sector in preparation for Connect Care implementation.

Action Required:

• Be aware of the changes in the lower reportable range and critical value of salicylate.
