Discontinue faxing of IVIG Screening Form TM2038 Re:

PLEASE POST OR DISTRIBUTE AS WIDELY AS APPROPRIATE

Key Message:

- Effective July 13, 2020, faxing of completed Immune Globulin Initiation forms (Form TM2038) will no longer be required.
- Diagnosis will be obtained when orders are submitted. For any questions, Transfusion Medicine will contact the unit.

Why this is Important:

Further screening is not required at this time since appropriate utilization of products has been confirmed.
