Re: Discontinue using APTIMA Collection Kits/Swabs for COVID-19 Testing Immediately

PLEASE POST OR DISTRIBUTE AS WIDELY AS APPROPRIATE

Key Message:

DO NOT USE APTIMA

Multitest or Unisex Swabs for COVID-19 testing.

Use nasopharyngeal or throat swabs recommended and distributed by APL/AHS specifically for COVID-19 testing,

APTIMA * swab specimen collection kits are the only collection kits available for *Chlamydia trachomatis* (CT) and *Neisseria gonorrhoeae* (GC) nucleic acid testing in Alberta. These swabs are in **short supply** due to global demand.

Why this is important:

Due to supply chain problems associated with the COVID-19 pandemic, supplies of APTIMA ® swabs are being restricted globally. APL is working with the manufacturer of APTIMA ® swabs to ensure an adequate supply is maintained to continue STI testing at current levels.

Early in the COVID-19 pandemic, APL recommended APTIMA ® swabs for COVID-19 testing because availability of other types of collection kits was limited. Other collection kits containing nasopharyngeal or throat swabs are now available for COVID-19. To ensure adequate supply of APTIMA ® swabs for STI testing, APTIMA collection kits should not be used for COVID-19 testing.

Action Required:

- 1. For COVID-19 testing, use swabs OTHER than the APTIMA ® swabs.
- 2. Closely monitor distribution of APTIMA ® swabs and order only what is required for a one month supply.
