**Key Messages:**

- *DynaLIFE<sub>Dx</sub>* is pleased to announce that ECG tracings interpreted by the *DynaLIFE<sub>Dx</sub>* ECG panel are now available for viewing in Netcare. Previously, only the interpretation had been published to Netcare.
- The inability to compare the actual tracings had resulted in difficulties in patient care, especially when normal ECG variants were present, or acute changes had occurred. We have responded to your feedback, and addressed this concern. We believe that this should contribute significantly to improvements in patient care.

- When you have logged into Netcare and opened your patient record the ECG tracings are located in the Menu as shown below:
