Re: Electron Microscopy Testing of Platelet or other Hematology Specimen

# PLEASE POST OR DISTRIBUTE AS WIDELY AS APPROPRIATE

#### **Key Message:**

• Effective October 08, 2020, EM testing on all hematology specimen has to be ordered through the new test "Hematology Electron Microscopy/ Hematology EM (Lab ID: LAB6133A)" in Epic. This includes EM testing of platelet whole mounts, platelet or granulocyte thin sections or any other custom EM hematology testing. The new test replaces the previous test "Platelet Electron Microscopy/EM". However, the previous test name is still a searchable synonym for the new test. Importantly, laboratory results for this test are no longer reported under "Surgical Pathology", but under "Hematology Electron Microscopy" in the Patient Chart.

## **Background:**

 These changes facilitate laboratory internal accessioning for this cross departmental test and harmonize provincial result reporting. The new test name more accurately represents the specimen types processed through this test.
