- Surgical Pathology and Non Gynecologic Cytopathology tests orders now have a hard stop in place to capture relevant clinical history/information.
- These fields must be completed with the clinical information you think will aid the pathologist in the diagnostic workup of the specimen.

Why this is important:

- Relevant clinical history informs specimen processing decisions in order to provide optimum patient diagnoses.
- Provision of relevant clinical history is a CPSA accreditation standard and is required as part of the Laboratory Sample Acceptance Policy.
