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## **Key Messages:**

As of May 7, 2014 the Molecular Pathology Laboratory has implemented an expanded mutation panel for BRAF testing.

#### Why this is important:

The new assay enables the detection of V600E/Ec, V600K, V600R and V600D mutations. These additional mutations are indicated for targeted therapy in melanoma.
