Re: Expansion of Rapid COVID-19 Testing to Emergency Department Patients at QEII

# PLEASE POST OR DISTRIBUTE AS WIDELY AS APPROPRIATE

#### **Key Message:**

- Effective May 21, 2020, requests for rapid COVID-19 testing on specimens submitted from
   Emergency Department (ED) patients at Queen Elizabeth II Hospital (QEII) and surrounding
   rural hospitals will be performed using the rapid GeneXpert® nucleic acid test (NAT). All
   inpatients that meet criteria for rapid testing and have rapid testing ordered will continue to have
   the GeneXpert® test performed.
- Specimens will be transported to QEII by routine courier.
- Acceptable specimens include nasopharyngeal swabs or throat swabs (polyester or cotton) in Universal Transport Media (UTM), sterile saline or eSwab<sup>™</sup> media, endotracheal tube aspirates, and bronchoalveolar lavages.
- Specimens collected from patients in assessment centres and in the community will continue to be forwarded to the APL Public Health Laboratory.

### Why this is Important:

- The GeneXpert<sup>®</sup> assay targets the N and S genes of SARS-CoV-2, the etiologic agent of COVID-19.
- Its performance is comparable to the laboratory-developed test used at the APL Public Health Laboratory. Additional confirmatory testing is not necessary.
- Because of limited supply, this test is currently being offered to hospital ED and inpatients only.


#### **Action Required:**

- Ensure all orders for rapid COVID-19 are submitted in Meditech (see flow chart attached).
  - o If rapid COVID-19 testing is required, order as "rapid COVID-19".
  - o If COVID-19 testing is needed, but not urgently, order as "routine COVID-19".
  - o If testing for other respiratory viruses is needed, order "RPP". The respiratory pathogen panel (RPP) will no longer be automatically performed on all COVID-19 tests.
- Repeat rapid COVID-19 test requests and testing of outpatients will continue to be sent to the APL
   Public Health Laboratories in Edmonton.
- All results will be available in Netcare. The results will not be viewable in Meditech.
- Contact and droplet precautions should only be discontinued in accordance with Infection
  Prevention and Control (IPC) guidelines or consultation and should take into account the patient's
  clinical and radiological findings.



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- Ordering staff: all COVID-19 and other viral testing should be ordered as VIROV1.
