#### Key Messages:

- Effective December 15, 2013, phosphatidylglycerol testing for fetal lung maturity in diabetic pregnancies will no longer be available at the Royal Alexandra Hospital (RAH) Laboratory.
- Phosphatidylglycerol was available as a confirmatory test for diabetic pregnancies with a
  positive fetal lung maturity (FLM) test result. However, the FLM test became unavailable in
  summer 2013 owing to lack of reagent availability. Because of this and the very low request
  frequency for phosphatidylglycerol, RAH will no longer be offering the phosphatidylglycerol
  test.
