Re: Hereditary Cancer Testing

Key Messages:

- The Molecular Diagnostic Laboratories have recently noticed an increase in the number of referrals for hereditary cancer testing.
- Genetic testing for hereditary cancer syndromes such as BRCA1/2 can be ordered <u>only</u> through the Cancer Genetics Program and only for patients meeting <u>high-risk criteria</u>.
- If there is concern about a personal or family history of cancer, a referral to Medical Genetics is required before samples will be accepted for testing. Please contact the appropriate clinic for referral criteria:
