- Effective **August 6, 2019**, all IVIG orders will require submission of a completed Immune Globulin Initiation Form TM2038 (<https://www.albertahealthservices.ca/lab/Page10035.aspx>) and faxed to 403-270-7205.

- Screening of all Immunoglobulin orders is an important step to the appropriate utilization of blood products.

Action Required:

- All new “Request for Services IVIG” orders and annual renewal orders will require the submission of a completed TM2038 form and faxed to Transfusion Medicine at 403-270-7205.
- Continue to book your patients for infusions according to the Day Medicine Standardized booking process.
- If the order needs adjustment, the Transfusion Medicine physician will communicate directly with the ordering physician.
