Key Messages:

- The Edmonton Zone Anatomical Pathology Laboratory Information System (CoPath Application) that was expected to be up at 05:00 Monday, June 20, 2016 is delayed and is expected to be fully operational by Tuesday start of working day.
- Previously signed out patient reports continue to be viewable in Netcare
- Reports will not be available from CoPath, nor can they be generated or finalized, during this continued outage.

Why this is important:

- Given the progress on the Copath Upgrade, the decision to continue was approved by Laboratory and IT Executive as the upgrade is required to improve performance, supportability and reliability for this critical application.

Action Required:

- Use Netcare to view any Anatomical Pathology results from the Edmonton Zone.
- Please contact your Laboratory Site Chiefs for verbal preliminaries or temporary written reports on any urgently required patient results.
