From: Clinical Biochemistry, South Sector Re: Lower Reporting Limit for Salicylate

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### **Key Message:**

• Effective **September 2**, **2020**, the lower reporting limit for Salicylate was changed from <0.12 mmol/L to <0.30 mmol/L.

## Why this is Important:

An unidentified interference on the Siemens Vista analyzers appears to be responsible for an
increased number of borderline false positive results for Salicylates in the range of 0.20 mmol/L.
Changing the reporting limit will prevent these low positive results.

### **Action Required:**

- None at this time.
- The Meditech LIS has been updated to reflect these changes.
