#### **Key Message:**

Effective May 6, 2020 the Brooks Laboratory will implement a new hematology analyzer. Please note the following changes:

- Automated differential will change from a five part diff to a six part diff
- New reference range for absolute Immature Granulocytes of <1.0 x 10<sup>5</sup>/L. Remaining CBC parameter reference ranges will remain unchanged.
- Reduced actual sample volume for pediatric patients from 185uL to 25uL.

#### Why this is important:

 Laboratory Services are striving to provide new Hematology Instruments to promote timely delivery of accurate results.

#### **Action Required:**

 Use new reference range noted above to interpret patient results. Laboratory reports will reflect these changes.
