Peace River laboratory is now analyzing specimens for Alkaline Phosphatase using a new methodology. This has resulted in new Reference Ranges for this analyte.

140 – 440 U/L
10-16 years F
154 – 500 U/L
175 -625 U/L
≥17 years M/F
35-125 U/L
