Re: Reporting Results on Referred Out Pathology Samples - Quality & Patient Safety Initiative

# PLEASE POST OR DISTRIBUTE AS WIDELY AS APPROPRIATE

### Key Messages:

- Re-transcribing of the referred out pathology diagnosis into Meditech ("back order entry") is an opportunity for error and has the potential to impact quality and patient safety.
- In consultation with North Zone senior physician leaders, an alternate protocol for referred out pathology sample management and report delivery will be implemented <u>in the former Peace Country Health</u> <u>Region</u>.
- The changed protocol improves quality and patient safety while also supporting physician needs in obtaining access to completed pathology reports in a timely fashion.

### Effective January 2, 2014:

- For those pathology cases performed in Grande Prairie No changes will occur. The entire pathology
  report will continue to be available in Meditech for viewing as soon as the case is finalized by the
  pathologist.
- For those pathology cases that are referred out for testing Instead of the re-transcribed diagnosis being entered into Meditech (which has the potential for error), these cases will now be resulted in Meditech with the following comment:
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# > "Sample referred out for testing. See Netcare and/or paper report."

This activity will cause the pathology button in the Electronic Medical Record (EMR) to turn RED.

- The full report for referred out pathology will be available by hardcopy and in Alberta Netcare.
- Netcare can be accessed from the Meditech EMR by clicking the "**Netcare Link**" button on the right EMR menu bar. Clicking on the button will take the user directly to that patient record in Netcare (*Alberta Netcare Portal access is required*).
