Re: Change in PTT Heparin Therapeutic Range Level

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#### **Key Messages:**

- Due to a change in Activated Partial Thromboplastin Time (PTT) reagent, the PTT heparin therapeutic range will be changed effective *Tuesday*, *December 4*, *2012 at 0700 hours*.
- The new PTT heparin therapeutic range for monitoring patients on unfractionated heparin will be 55 95 seconds.

#### Why this is important:

• The change in unfractionated heparin therapeutic range will affect heparin dosing and will require changes to the heparin nomograms.

#### **Action Required:**

 This change has been communicated to the Pharmacy Department and changes to the unfractionated heparin nomograms will be made and communicated to clinicians to be implemented on December 4, 2012.
