#### Key Message:

- Effective 14 September 2020, the Cold Agglutinin Screen orderable in Connect Care will be inactivated.
- Order **Cold Agglutinin Titre** when either a Cold Agglutinin Screen or Titre is required.

### Why this is Important:

- Cold Agglutinin Screen is only performed in the Calgary zone.
- Cold Agglutinin Titre results were being delayed when Cold Agglutinin Screen was ordered, due to testing being referred to Calgary.
- Inactivating the Cold Agglutinin Screen in Connect Care will ensure testing is referred to the correct testing laboratory.
- The lab will be responsible for performing and resulting the correct test as per zone process.

### Background:

- Cold Agglutinin Testing protocols are different between zones.
- In Calgary Zone, a Cold Agglutinin Screen is ordered by the clinician and performed prior to the Cold Agglutinin Titre, while in other zones, the Cold Agglutinin Titre is performed without a prior screen test.

### **Action Required:**

• If either Cold Agglutinin Screen or Titre is required, order Cold Agglutinin Titre in Connect Care.
