Re: Expansion of Acceptable Swab and Transport Media Types for

HSV/VZV and Syphilis PCR

PLEASE POST OR DISTRIBUTE AS WIDELY AS APPROPRIATE

Key message:

- Provlab has validated a number of swabs and transportation media for Herpes Simplex virus / Varicella zoster virus (HSV/VZV) PCR assay and syphilis PCR assay.
- Acceptable collection kits include:
 - o UTM
 - o E-swab/Mini e-swab
 - o Saline swab kit
 - o Aptima collection kit

Background:

- Provlab has validated several alternative swabs and transportation media to accommodate the shortage of lesion swabs and transportation media during COVID-19 pandemic.
- Use of collection kits other than those mentioned above may compromise the sensitivity of the assay.

Action Required:

Please collect swabs for HSV/VZV or syphilis PCR with one of the approved collection kits.
