Re: Screening for CPO (Carbapenemase Producing Organisms; Previously Referred to as

CRE – Carbapenemase Resistant Enterobacteriaceae)

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Key Messages:

- Only rectal swabs and feces are acceptable specimens for CPO screening.
- Only one CPO screen per patient per week will be processed.
- CPO screening has to be approved by an Infection Control Nurse (ICN) prior to specimen collection.

Why this is important:

• If the above criteria are not met, the CPO screen request will not be processed.

Action Required:

- Consult the UAH Infection Control CPO screening criteria
- Consult an ICN prior to taking the specimens.
