Re: Change to Chemistry Collection Tube Requirements

PLEASE POST OR DISTRIBUTE AS WIDELY AS APPROPRIATE

Key Messages:

- Effective August 28, 2013 The main blood collection tube for Chemistry tests will be changing from Gold SST (Serum) to Light Green Lithium Heparin (Plasma). This change will support faster sample processing.
- The <u>potassium</u> reference range for adults will change to <u>3.3 4.8 mmol/L</u> to reflect a plasma collection.
- If Troponin testing is requested in addition to other blood work, a separate Lithium Heparin tube is required.
- Please continue to refer to the AHS Edmonton Zone Test Directory at: http://www.albertahealthservices.ca/3217.asp for collection and handling requirements as some tests still require a serum sample.

Why this is important:

• The change to a Lithium Heparin collection tube will standardize collection requirements in acute care sites across the Edmonton Zone.

Action Required:

- Ensure staff authorized to collect blood samples are aware of the new tube type requirements.
- Ensure your case cart has been stocked with an adequate supply of Lithium Heparin tubes (Cat # 612499).
