Re: South Zone East Service Transition –Community Based Non-Gynecological Cytology

Processing & Screening

Key Messages:

- <u>Effective January 1, 2016</u>, Medicine Hat Diagnostic Laboratory (MHDL) will discontinue processing, screening and reporting community non-gynecological cytology samples in South Zone East.
- Samples collected at physician offices in Medicine Hat, Brooks, Bassano, Bow Island and Oyen will be transferred from Medicine Hat Regional Hospital Lab (MHRH) daily to Chinook Regional Hospital (CRH) Laboratory for <u>processing</u>, <u>staining</u> and <u>screening</u> by the cytology department.
- Screened slides will be returned to MHRH for review and final diagnosis by the Medicine Hat Pathologist. This process is the same as is currently used for hospital based non-gyne cytology samples.
- Liquid Based Cytology using ThinPrep methodology will now be available for community cytology samples in Phase 1 of the transition.

- MHDL Courier pick up of samples at physician offices and delivery to Medicine Hat Regional Hospital.
- MHDL Courier delivery of paper reports.
- MHDL Courier delivery of collection supplies.
- Reports are also in Meditech EMR, NetCare and electronically to physician office systems.

Why this is important:

- It is essential that Cytology samples collected at MHRH Lab are reported by Pathologists in Medicine Hat to correlate the Cytology diagnosis/findings with any corresponding biopsy. This ensures appropriate patient management is maintained.
- Liquid Based Cytology is the primary method of Cytology sample processing. The ThinPrep processing method enhances the sensitivity and specificity of a result.



Action Required:
