

Re: Removal of 2 Unit Default for Ordering RBC in Meditech

# PLEASE POST OR DISTRIBUTE AS WIDELY AS APPROPRIATE

## **Key Messages:**

- Effective October 19, 2015, when ordering Red Blood Cells in Meditech, the Quantity field will no longer default to 2 units.
- The Quantity field will be blank and must be completed with the number of units to be transfused.
- Meditech will not allow the Quantity field to be bypassed. Attempting to do so will result in the error message "1 required field is missing in this row"



## Why this is important:

- The frequency of single unit RBC transfusions is increasing in our zone, in line with Choosing Wisely Canada guidelines and transfusion best practice.
- Removal of the 2 unit default will help ensure that only the quantity of RBC units required for transfusion are ordered, which supports better management of our local blood supply.

#### **Action Required:**

- When ordering Red Blood Cells in Meditech, enter the number of units required for transfusion in the Quantity field
- Do not order more units than will be transfused. Additional units may be requested at a later time using the "Add Units" routine.
