Re: Laboratory Outpatient Service in Brooks - January 7, 2013 to January 8, 2013

PLEASE POST OR DISTRIBUTE AS WIDELY AS APPROPRIATE

Key Messages:

Out patient laboratory services may be delayed or unavailable for the next 24-48 hours, effective immediately.

- Due to an outbreak of a Gastrointestinal Illness in several laboratory staff, there are very limited staffing resources available for the next 48 hours.
- Patients with non-urgent or routine orders are encouraged to come back in 24-48 hours when staffing levels have returned to normal and the risk of transmission to patients is reduced.
- Urgent and time sensitive test requests will still be processed.

Why this is important:

 Staffing levels need to be maintained for urgent and inpatient services, and if they are further reduced we may be required to close outpatient services for a short period of time.
