Re: Updated Trauma Order Sets at Red Deer Regional Hospital

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Key Messages:

- **Effective July 5, 2016**, new Trauma Order Sets will be available at the Red Deer Hospital, following the request of the Central Zone Trauma Program and the direction of Alberta Trauma Services. This will allow patient results to better meet the needs of the provincial trauma registry.
 - There are currently no changes to trauma orders at other Central Zone sites.
- The new order sets will improve appropriate lab investigation based on trauma severity and ease the test order entry process, however each physician can modify their required order to an individual patient, if clinically required.

Action Required:

- The following codes will no longer be available: ERTRAU and ERTRAUMAF
- The **new order codes** are:
 - ERTRAUMMIN: ER Trauma – Minor Trauma
 - Included tests: beta hCG (F; 10-60 years), CBC, creatinine, carbon dioxide, electrolytes, ethanol (≥13 yrs), random glucose, lipase, urea
 - ERTRAUMMAJ: ER Trauma – Major Trauma
 - Included tests: alanine aminotransferase, beta hCG (F; 10-60 years), total bilirubin, calcium, carbon dioxide, CBC, creatinine kinase, creatinine, electrolytes, ethanol (≥13 yrs), fibrinogen, random glucose, lactate, lipase, magnesium, osmolality, PT/INR, PTT, troponin, type and screen, urea, urinalysis
