Comprehensive Drug Screens are intended for medical purposes (e.g. treatment) only. APL Calgary does not endorse or recommend ordering drug tests simply to reassure patients that they will test negative when a subsequent employment or forensic drug screen is performed.

Specimen collection requirements: 30 mL urine

Both Patient Information and Patient History sections of this form must be completed in order for testing to be performed. Send completed form and requisition with patient for collection.

Stat requests are restricted to acute care sites and require testing approval.
