Key Message:

The 2009/2010 Antibiogram for the former David Thompson Health Region (DTHR) sites is now available.

Why it is important:

The antibiogram is an annual cumulative report of the antimicrobial susceptibility rates of common microbial pathogens to antimicrobials available on the hospital formulary. This report represents the local microbial epidemiology of the former DTHR sites and is intended to be used as a guideline to direct empiric antimicrobial therapy.
