Key Messages:

Lee Crest Daily Assisted Living (DAL) will be opening in Cardston on January 31, 2011. The laboratory collection day for Lee Crest residents will be **Tuesday mornings**. Routine laboratory work will be collected for all residents starting Tuesday, **February 1, 2011.**

Action Required:

• Physicians are asked to consolidate resident collections for the scheduled collection day (Tuesday mornings).

Why this is important:

- The Laboratory provides service to all departments within the Cardston Hospital and collections for Lee Crest involve a staff member leaving the Cardston Hospital facility.
- To maximize our limited laboratory resources, weekly trips to Lee Crest are more efficient.
- We do understand that occasionally a <u>clinically necessary</u> collection may have to be done outside of this scheduled day. Please help us keep such occurrences to a minimum in order for the laboratory to provide appropriate service to all of our clients.
