Re: White Blood Cell (WBC) Critical Values Notification

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### **Key Messages:**

• Effective, July 15, 2011, the protocol for phoning of critical WBC results to the ward or physician office is changing. The laboratory will call WBC counts of greater than 30 x 10<sup>9</sup>/L on the first occurrence only.

### Why this is important:

- Currently, all WBC counts greater than 30 x 10<sup>9</sup>/L are called to the ward or physician office. This often results in repeat phone calls for patients with a known leukemia or infection.
- To reduce the number of repeat calls on patients with known high WBC counts, the laboratory will call WBC counts of greater than 30 x 10<sup>9</sup>/L on the first occurrence only.
