Key Messages:

Effective immediately, the Bleeding Time test is no longer available at the Bow Island Health Centre and Brooks Health Centre laboratories.

Why this is important:

- Bleeding time is not a useful test because it is neither sensitive nor specific.
- Due to the manual nature of the test and variations in patient skin texture and thickness, the results are not reproducible.
- Depending on the clinical situation personal or family history of bleeding, the nature of the bleeding (mucosal or soft tissue), presence of thrombocytopenia or use of non-steroidal anti-inflammatory drugs or anti-platelet agents more sensitive and specific tests are available.
