## Continue to process all Newborn Metabolic Screening requisitions as priority samples.

As of 16 July 2012, the Person Directory (PD) and the Newborn Metabolic Screening (NMS) application have both been fully restored. Infants can now be registered in PD after birth and their newborn metabolic screening status can be tracked in the NMS application. Most infant registrations from the downtime period have been completed and Unique Lifetime Identifiers (ULI) should now be available for all infants.

If a <u>ULI is not available</u> as operations return to normal <u>OR</u> if a ULI is unavailable at any point, please continue with the following procedure

## Collections without a ULI

- Do not delay collection of a Newborn Metabolic Screening sample
- Write "ULI unavailable" in the ULI field on the Newborn Metabolic Screening requisition
- Write the medical record number (MRN) in the chart number field on the Newborn Metabolic Screening requisition
