Re: LB-13-11 New Method For ESR Testing

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Key Messages:

Effective June 1, 2011, South Zone - West laboratories will be implementing the Sediplast® ESR System. Comparison studies were performed against the current Westergren method and the results were similar with the greatest differences noted in patients with high ESRs.

The change to the Sediplast® ESR System also involves a change in the normal range. The new normal range is provided in the following chart:

Age:	Male	Female
Under 50 years	0-15 mm/hr	0-20 mm/hr
Over 50 years	0-20 mm/hr	0-30 mm/hr

Why this is important:

The Sediplast® ESR System is a completely closed system. It provides greater safety and convenience as well as reliable and reproducible test results.
