Re: LB-29-11 Disposal of Expired Laboratory Supplies

PLEASE POST OR DISTRIBUTE AS WIDELY AS APPROPRIATE

Key Messages:

Effective October 17, 2011, physician offices and clinics may dispose of all non-chemical expired supplies on-site.

Chemical supplies with an attached MSDS label should continue to be sent to the laboratory for disposal. The following are examples of these supplies:

- Cytolyt
- Urine Cytology kits
- SAF O&P fixative containers
- EPT Stool preservative containers
- 10% Formalin containers

Why this is important:

Currently all expired lab supplies are returned to Chinook Regional Hospital Laboratory for disposal. This change will reduce the handling and transport of expired products.

Action Required:

- Physician offices should begin disposing of all non-chemical expired lab supplies on-site.
- Expired chemical supplies should be sent to the laboratory Attn: Laboratory Safety.
