• The St. Therese Health Care Centre Laboratory in St. Paul will discontinue Ova and Parasite tesing (O&P) effective February 13, 2012.

• All future specimens requiring O&P testing will be forwarded to the Provincial Laboratory for Public Health (ProvLab) for processing.
