Re: 28-10 Oxycodone HCI (OxyContin) Screening

PLEASE POST OR DISTRIBUTE AS WIDELY AS APPROPRIATE

Key Message:

The <u>Urine Drug Screen Kit</u> currently used by Chinook Regional Hospital Laboratory does not readily detect Oxycodone.

Why this is important:

Requesting a standard urine drug screen when wanting to screen a patient's urine specimen for Oxycodone, will not provide the appropriate result.

Action Required:

When requesting a screen for Oxycodone:

- Submit a urine specimen (10 15 mL preferred) for analysis.
- Write "screen for Oxycodone" in the "Other Tests / Comments" box on the lower right hand corner of the South Zone West Laboratory / Microbiology Request form. The lab will then process the specimen to ensure the correct test is performed.
