



How to prepare	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Use the Pinworm Collection Kit provided
Risks or Cautions	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Specimen MUST be collected in the morning BEFORE bathing or using the toilet. DO NOT wipe or wash the anal area before collecting the sample. Wash hands thoroughly after collection as pinworm eggs are highly infectious.
Labelling the Sample	<p>Label the collection container with:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Your (the patient) full first and last name, date and time of collection, Provincial Health Insurance (PHN/ULI), or Government issued identification such as (Federal, Military, RCMP, Immigration, Passport #) If you have been provided with a patient label, attach this label to the outside of the container. Incorrectly or incompletely labeled specimens may not be tested.
Lab Requisition	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Print the date/time the sample was collected on your lab requisition. Fold and place the requisition in the outside pocket of the biohazard bag. Do not put the requisition in the bag with the sample collection container.
Collecting the Sample	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> Take the paddle attached to the lid out of the container. Separate the buttocks and press the sticky surface of the square end firmly against the skin around and across the anal opening. Do Not insert the paddles into the rectum. Return the paddle to the labeled specimen container. Secure the lid tightly. Wash hands thoroughly after collection. Place container into biohazard bag. <div style="display: flex; justify-content: space-around; align-items: center;">   </div>
Sample Delivery to Lab	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Return sample and requisition to the laboratory as soon as possible. If unable to return sample to the laboratory immediately, keep sample in fridge. Sample MUST be returned to the laboratory the same day it is collected Prolonged delays may affect the test results.
