

Re: Clostridium difficile Toxin Screening Method Standardization

PLEASE POST OR DISTRIBUTE AS WIDELY AS APPROPRIATE

Key Message:

- Effective April 17, 2013, a new screening test for *Clostridium difficile* (TechLab® C. diff Quik Chek Complete™) will be implemented at the Provincial Laboratory for Public Health (ProvLab).
- This assay offers improved sensitivity over the previously used enzyme immunoassay.
- Grossly soft or liquid stool samples will first be tested with the TechLab® C. diff Quik Chek Complete™ and the following algorithm will be applied:



Why this is important:

Implementation of TechLab® C. diff Quik Chek Complete™ will:

- Standardize C.difficile testing in the province
- Contribute to improved patient care including
 - > Reduction of unnecessary patient isolation
 - Decrease length of stay
 - Assist with appropriate antibiotic usage
 - > Improve patient outcomes by providing optimal treatments earlier

Action Required:

Note changes such as:

- Specimens should be kept refrigerated and transported to the laboratory as soon as possible.
- Repeat *C. difficile* testing on previous negative or positive sample within 7 days will only be performed if approved by the Microbiologist-on-Call.
