Re: Change in PTT Reference and PTT Heparin Therapeutic Ranges

at Edmonton Zone Inpatient Sites

Key Messages:

 Effective May 17th, 2011 at 0001h, there will be a PTT reagent change in all hospital laboratories in the Edmonton Zone.

Why this is important:

 New PTT reference ranges and PTT heparin therapeutic ranges (for monitoring full dose unfractionated heparin therapy) will become effective May 17th, 2011 at 0001h. Please refer to the chart below for sitespecific details.
