Re: Revised Prothrombin Complex Concentrate Request Form

Key Messages:

The revised Prothrombin Complex Concentrate (PCC) Request Form (Version 1.6) is now available at www.albertahealthservices.ca/5496.asp

The Prothrombin Complex Concentrate (PCC) Request Form has been revised to include the patient's history of Heparin Induced Thrombocytopenia (HIT). If testing has been performed, HIT assay results will be in the 'Coagulation' section of Netcare.

Why this is important:

PCCs are contraindicated in patients with HIT due to the presence of heparin in PCCs. If requesting PCCs for a patient with a current or past positive HIT history, the Transfusion Medicine Physician on-call should be paged through Locating.

Action Required:

Remove existing copies of old versions of the PCC Request Form.
