Re: **ALERT** Vitamin B12 Testing Reinstated

PLEASE POST OR DISTRIBUTE AS WIDELY AS APPROPRIATE

Key Message:

Background	 The Chinook Regional Hospital Laboratory performs approximately 24, 000 vitamin B12 tests annually for patients in South Zone West. The laboratory has received a different reagent formulation for the Centaur analyzer.
Assessment	 Vitamin B12 testing will resume at Chinook Hospital on May 29, 2012. The Centaur method has established a Patient Reference Range Change of >150 pmol/L.
RECOMMENDATION	 Resume normal ordering practices Consider retesting of patients utilizing criteria in Laboratory Bulletin titled Vitamin B12 – Interference from Intrinsic Factor Blocking Antibodies dated May 29, 2012.
