

## Appropriate Use of Antipsychotics Family Conference Tracking Record

- The purpose of the Tracking Record is to document the discussions / decisions / next steps related to antipsychotic use.
- Discussions are ongoing and may include any combination of the 7 core elements listed below.
- Any member of the interdisciplinary team may initiate or participate in discussions related to antipsychotic use

## **Topics**

- 1. Responsive behavior: description, frequency, severity, timing
- 2. Interventions: care approaches and strategies, non pharmacological measures, treatment of underlying conditions
- 3. Consent to reduce / discontinue antipsychotic medication
- 4. Appropriate use of antipsychotic medication, benefits and risks
- 5. Consent to use antipsychotic medication
- 6. Review of changes to treatment: baseline measurements and response
- 7. Disclosure of Harm: to resident/by resident
